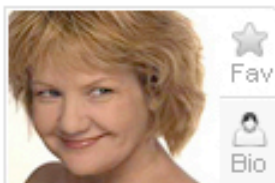

Directed by Charles Messina and written and performed by Andrew Goffman, *The Accidental Pervert* is the true accounting of one boy's odyssey to manhood via a childhood dominated by pornography. Happening upon his father's collection of XXX-rated video tapes in the bedroom closet at 11, his journey begins. Goffman hysterically takes us on a self-deprecating journey into a world of video vixens, X-rated fantasies, and really dirty movies, until at 26 he meets
